THIS PROJECT WILL BE FUNDED BY AN ARP (AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN) GRANT AND IS CONTINGENT UPON FINAL APPROVAL FROM KNOX COUNTY. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CONSULTING ENGINEER, FOX P.E., THE PROJECT WAS AWARDED TO THE LOW BIDDER: MORGAN CONTRACTING, INC. FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$2,744,000.00 ON A MOTION BY MS. BARGER, SECOND BY MR. COOK. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
